Position: Leader in Training (LIT)

Goal: To develop important camp skills while serving, helping and nurturing a love for

camp ministry, and gain an understanding about camp operation and the

positions within.

Requirements:

1. Be at least 14 years of age

- 2. Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and show signs of Christian growth
- 3. Be involved in a church
- 4. Have completed and handed in a LIT application including references and Criminal record check (if 18 or older).
- 5. Pay the entrance fee of \$50

Responsibilities:

- 1. Attend all LIT group training sessions, devotions and meetings.
- 2. Be on time for the pre-camp staff meeting and welcome campers as they arrive.
- 3. Be prepared to lead a cabin devotion time.
- 4. Be prepared to assist in leading a skill activity.
- 5. Spend time with campers and build relationships with them. Put your campers first and be fully present.
- 6. Be prepared to give leadership in the cabins if asked.
- 7. Be prepared to serve in other areas of the camp (Kitchen, Maintenance).
- 8. Live a life that reflects Christian morals and values in front of the campers at camp and away from camp.
- 9. Take time each day for personal reflection, prayer, and devotions.
- 10. Be prepared to help out in other areas of the camp as called upon.

Working Relationships:

- 1. Report to the LIT Director and the Camp Director.
- 2. Work with and take direction from kitchen and maintenance staff when placed under their supervision.
